

Announcement from Udonpittayanukoon School

Subject: Policy on Not Accepting Gifts and Presents of Any Kind During the Performance of Duties (No Gift Policy) for the Fiscal Year 2023.

Udonpittayanukoon School recognizes the importance of fostering a corporate culture, values, and appropriate guidelines for personnel to follow regarding the giving or receiving of gifts, presents, or other benefits related to the performance of their duties. This is to prevent actions that could influence the abuse of power for personal or others' benefit, in accordance with government policy and the anti-corruption and misconduct reform plan.

To demonstrate our commitment to combating all forms of corruption and to promote virtues, ethics, and integrity in our work, which will result in transparency and adherence to good governance principles, Udonpittayanukoon School hereby announces that all personnel are prohibited from accepting any gifts or presents in relation to their duties, whether before, during, or after performing their tasks. This policy aims to avoid actions that could affect judgment or decision-making in performing duties, which may lead to discrimination or conflicts of interest. All levels of management are expected to set a good example and oversee their staff to ensure proper conduct and strict adherence to anti-corruption and misconduct prevention measures.
